Note: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration at either CVCC or Mitchell Community College.

Purpose: *To provide scholarships to area High School and College Students going into the EMS, Police, Fire or Rescue fields.*

Award Components: Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships and individual certificates awarded to two (2) students

Criteria:

- Must be pursuing a career in the Police, Fire, Rescue or EMS fields
- Attending either CVCC or Mitchell Community College

Application Process: Applicant must submit the following items:

- Completed application form (must be typed)
- Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation of career goals and biographical (background) information, including any experience in the Police, Fire, EMS or Rescue fields and future plans.
- Most recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average and a class standing/rank.
- Personal Essay. In your essay, please answer the question below.
