Please return this application to Claremont City Hall no later than December 2, 2019.

There is no entry fee to participate in the parade. A space number will be assigned to your entry once your application has been received. You will enter the staging area, which is right past the corner of Lookout Street and Centennial Blvd., where parade marshals will be available to direct you if needed. Please arrive no later than 2:15PM on the day of the parade.

There is a City Ordinance that states no objects may be thrown from a moving vehicle. Should you have any items that you would like to give out to the citizens on the curb, you may have individuals 18 or older walk along side your vehicle and give out the items. We trust that you will abide by this ordinance.

The Parade Committee asks that all units refrain from having a Santa as part of your presentation. The reason for this is many parents have stated that their child is confused with so many different Santa's. The official Santa is the last float of the parade and will greet all the children at City Hall after the parade.

The staging area will be on the east end of Centennial Blvd. All vehicles should enter the staging area turning from Lookout Street onto Centennial Blvd. As you enter the area one of the marshals can help direct you if you need help or to get your number. You may proceed on to your place in the parade. You will also receive this information in an email the week before with details so make sure Kara Miller has your email address. The parade will start and travel west on US Hwy. 70 to Oxford Street. The parade will turn right going north on Oxford Street and disband at Stanford Furniture and Hannah's BBQ. Anyone walking/marching/dancing in the parade can enter their designated, numbered spot where the parade officially begins at the City Park. Tractors will be staged at the cemetery on Hwy.70. There will be a parade marshal at these locations to help you get inserted at the right place.
