### **Everybody COUNTS! 2020 Census**

### Online Bill Pay

You can pay your water, sewer and/or trash bills online. There is a processing fee and you will need to make sure your bill is paid by 8PM on the 27th of every month. Visit the website to read about this process and check out our new, more convenient service!

## Annual Trash/Recycle Can Count

Starting in March, Republic will begin doing their annual count of each business and household's trash and recycle cans. Each household is allowed one trash and one recycle can through the City and each business is allowed two trash and one recycle. When doing their annual count if more than that number is found at an individual residence or business then they will be picking the extras up since they are not included. If you have contracted with Republic for extra cans or a dumpster then they will have that on their list and will not take them. If you have extra cans but have not contracted with Republic, you may contact them to pay them directly for any extra cans/dumpster you may want or need to Contact City Hall if you have any questions.
